The table shows the alignment between PHILINTER levels and scores achieved in internationally recognized English proficiency exams such as IELTS, TOEIC, TOEFL, and Cambridge. This provides students with a clear understanding of their performance on a global scale.

For example, an IELTS score of 6.5 corresponds to a TOEIC score range of 855 to 900 and a PHILINTER level of 401+.
